STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY (SSS) REPORT

In the historical city of Vijayapur, with the able efforts of the management members of Anjuman-e-Islam, the faculty of Arts started in the year 1972. It was a humble beginning, today it is a full-fledged college having Arts, Science & Commerce streams along with post graduation studies in English. As per accreditation process, NAAC accredited with B grade in I cycle and with A grade in II and III cycles.

The quality of teaching and learning process can be made effective by periodic collection of suggestions and feedback from students. In this regard the NAAC introduced an (SSS) metric of number 2.7.1 which is the part of criterion 2 (Teaching-Learning and Evaluation).

Objective: The objective of SSS is to measure the student's level of satisfaction on their experiences with institution. For the AQAR 2019-20 SSS was conducted among the pass out students of the institute. The questionnaire has been framed based on NAAC guidelines. The online survey responses from 72 students were collected and analysed.

Analysis: Total 72 students were participated in the survey, 40 students from Science stream, 16 students from Arts stream and 16 from commerce stream. It was found in the survey that 40.3% of the students agreed that 85 to 100% of the syllabus was completed in class room. 48.6% of students agreed about thorough class preparation of teacher. 48.6% of students were saying that teachers approach towards teaching is excellent. 61.1% of students voted for effective communication of teacher. Internal evaluation fairness is voted by 58.3% of students. 47.2% of students saying that teachers always discussed about their performance in assignment work. 44.4% of students voted for regular active interest institute in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students. 52.8% of students agreed that the institution significantly involved in facilitating their cognitive, social and emotional growth. 43.1% of the students strongly agreed that the institution provided them opportunities to grow and same percentage agreed about the same. 55.6% of students said every time and 31.9% said that the teachers inform usually them about expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes. 43.1% students said every time and 40.3% said usually regarding follow-up of students task assigned by the mentor. 61.1% of said that the teachers explained the concepts through application and examples every time and 23.6% said that it is done usually. 51.4% of the students had opinion that the teachers fully identified their strengths and encourage them by providing proper platform. 51.4% of students mentioned that teachers will help every time to overcome from their weaknesses and 30.6% said that it happens usually. 44.4% of students strongly agreed and 40.3% simply agreed that institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process. 51.4% of students said to a great extent, 34.7% said moderate use of student learning methodologies for enhanced learning experiences.

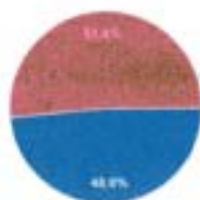
It was strongly agreed by 50% of the students and 40.3% simply agreed that the teachers encouraged them to participate in extracurricular activities. It was agreed to a large extent by 43.8% of the students that the teachers of the institute put efforts to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make them ready for the world of work and 36.1% of the students said that it was

done at moderate rate. 48.6% of students agreed that ICT and multimedia tools were used by 90% of the teachers and 27.8% of the students said that 70-89% of the teachers used such tools. The teaching and learning process of the institute is very good it was strongly agreed by 54.2% of the students while 37.5% of the students simply agreed with so.

Action Taken: After analysis of SSS, it was found that the overall response of the students was positive but some areas need to be strengthened. The pandemic period of COVID19 made a large impact on teaching and learning process. The issue was raised and discussed in the IQAC meeting steps were taken to rectify the same. The SSS report is uploaded and link is provided to various stakeholders.



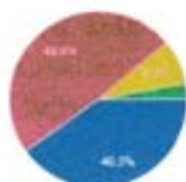

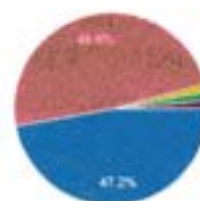

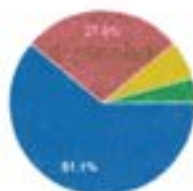
1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

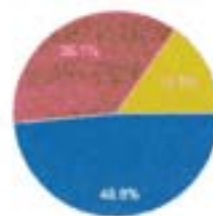
2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

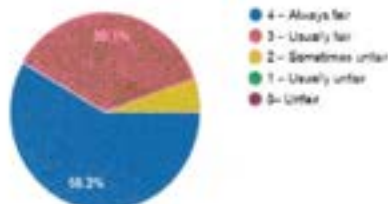


4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

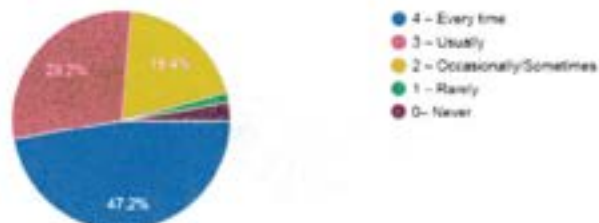
5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.

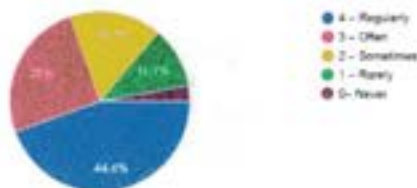

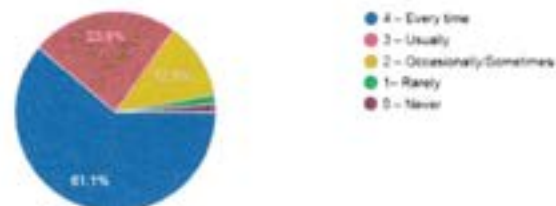

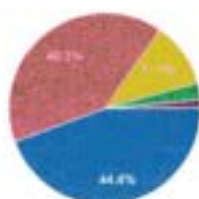

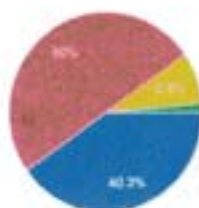

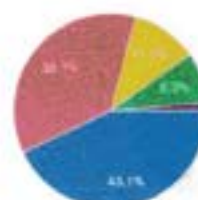

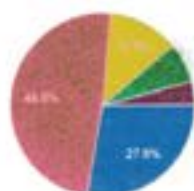

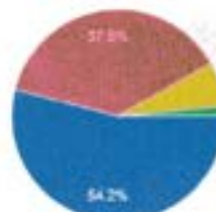
19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.
