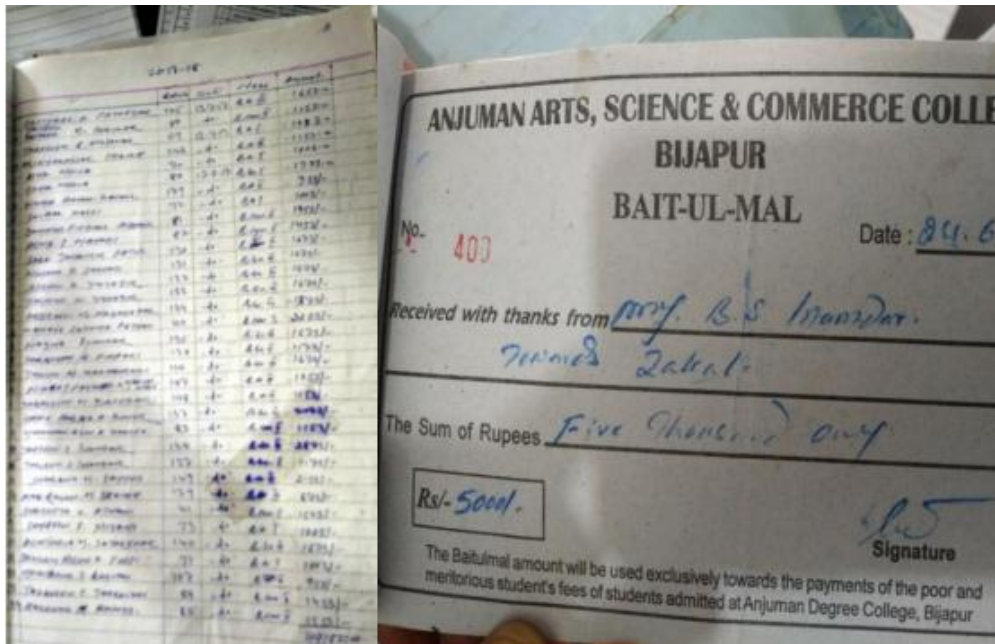


7.2 – Best Practices

Title of the Best Practices – I: “Baitul Maal (Charity Fund)”

1. **Goal:** To give financial support to the economically backward students in the process of learning in institution.
2. **The Context:** The most of the Students of North Karnataka are belonging to economical weaker section. The meritorious students used to drop their higher education due to financial burden. To support such students the Baitul Maal was formed. As our institute belongs to Muslim minority, the higher authority plans generate the fund for this task from Jakat (Every Muslim used give 2.5% of his year income for charity). The Baitul Maal committee formed to achieve this goal by identifying the beneficiaries and donors.
3. **The Practices:** For this purpose amount collected in the form of Jakat (2.5% of their yearly income). The collected amount has been distributed among the beneficiaries in the form of scholarships, to pay their admission fees.
4. **Evidence of Success:** For the academic 2019-20, about Rs.38000/- sanctioned to 60 economical weaker section students of the institute.
