Goal: To address issues in gender equality and encourage participants to pursue solutions.

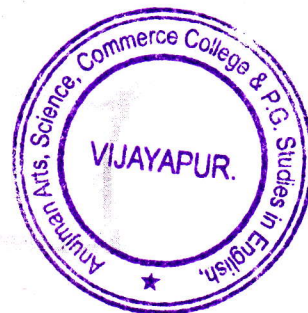
Aim: To conduct various gender sensitization campaigns, training centres, workshops, programs, etc.

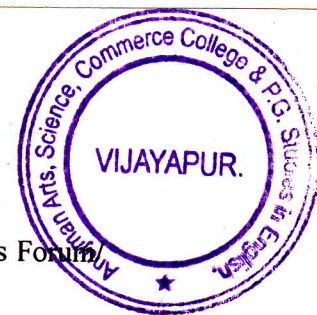
